Dushni Weerakoon is the Deputy Director and Head of Macroeconomic Policy Research at the Institute of Policy Studies of Sri Lanka (IPS) with 20 years of post-doctoral research and training experience in development issues. Her research and publications cover areas related to regional trade integration, macroeconomic policy, and international economics. She has extensive experience working in policy development committees and official delegations of the Government of Sri Lanka. These include the Macro and Trade Policy Steering Committee (Ministry of Policy Development and Implementation), official delegate to the Committee of Experts to negotiate the South Asian Free Trade Agreement (Ministry of Trade and Commerce) and Trade and Tariff Committee of the National Council for Economic Development (Ministry of Finance).

She has worked as a consultant to international organizations such as the Asian Development Bank (ADB), the World Bank, the United Nations Economic and Social Commission for Asia and the Pacific (UN-ESCAP), the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP), International Labour Organization (ILO) and the World Trade Organization (WTO).
